employers confidence in jobs market boosted

Following the major upturn in the UK economy, recruitment governing body REC has reported that there has been an end to many recruitment freezes and there is a new found optimism towards recruiting again. Figures suggest 44% of companies intend to recruit permanent staff within the next 3 months and that figure increases to 52% within the next 12 months. A fall in unemployment overall is accompanied by a huge surge in confidence on the employee side with 1 in 4 believing that there are new opportunities out there for them should they choose to look.

In relation to the markets we work in, we have seen the biggest surge in jobs in the retail interiors market and in particular for Project Managers. Across all markets, there is a real desire for growth with the establishment of new sales teams and an increase in the number of senior roles being recruited for.
